**NEWARK AVENUE PEDESTRIAN PLAZA IMPROVEMENTS  
DECORATIVE SIDEWALK COATING**

To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that the City's Contractor, JC Contracting, as part of the Newark Avenue Pedestrian Plaza Project #16-017-E, will continue to apply the decorative sidewalk coating on all the sidewalk areas on Newark Avenue between Barrow/Erie Streets and Grove Street. The work is planned to take place in the early morning hours and continue into the afternoon on consecutive Mondays. **The current schedule is to perform the work on Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup> and Monday, June 13<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 4:00 p.m. (weather and field conditions permitting).**

**Location Schedule:**

- Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup> 12:00a.m. to 4:00 p.m.– North side - 158 Newark Ave. to 138 Newark Ave.  
South side – 161 Newark Ave. to 133 Newark Ave.
- Monday, June 13<sup>th</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 12:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.– North side – 138 Newark Ave. to 126 Newark Ave  
South side – 133 Newark Ave. to 119 Newark Ave.**

**During this time, all merchants must remove all furniture, planters, displays, and objects that cover the sidewalk.**

Large sections of sidewalk will be closed and doorways may be inaccessible for a short duration while the coating cures. Crews will accommodate ingress and egress into buildings to the best of their ability. This may require pedestrians to navigate temporary walkways. The main plaza area will remain open for pedestrian access and shall be utilized in place of the closed sidewalk areas. Please be courteous and allow some extra time to navigate the sidewalk or ask for assistance from the team on site.

The contractor and all workers on site will be practicing social distancing and best practices in accordance with the guidance from CDC during the current COVID-19 pandemic. Responsible behaviors and preventative measures are kept in mind while maintaining and repairing the City's infrastructure. We want to work safely and fulfill the commitment as a public servant for the advancement of Jersey City, This work improves critical infrastructure that the public depends on.
